D1: Singapore to Chiang Mai

(-/L/D)

Pick up from Chiang Mai Airport, then send to Lunch at restaurant.

-**Doi Pui & Hmong Village, Doi Pui** is a neighboring peak on the same granite base as **Doi Suthep**. The **Hmong Village** at **Doi Pui** has a market and an impressive garden.

-**Huay Tung Tao Lake**, Man-made lake lined with bamboo huts & eateries serving local dishes, popular for walking & cycling. Dinner at restaurant.

D2: Chiang Mai - Fang

-**Queen Sirikit Botanic Garden**, is a world-class conservation centre for indigenous Thai plants as well as other exotic varieties from around the world.

-**I Love Flower Farm**, see a vast sea of flowers that you can't help but adore at I Love Flower Farm, where relaxation and refreshness combines in one place with all the colors of the nature! Bring out your phones or cameras, pose under the sun and smile wide, you will surely get some wonderful photos here. Capture your sweet memories and enjoy a trip exploring nature with I Love Flower Farm, Chiangmai.

-**Chiang Mai Long Neck Village, Long Neck Village** is located in the north of Thailand. Immerse yourself in various cultures when you visit the Hill Tribe and Long Neck Village. Lunch at Local restaurant.

-**Chiang Dao Cave**, enduring natural cave temple with stalactites & a fish pond, plus Buddhas & other religious statues.

-**Hinoki Land**, is a Japanese themed landscape and building compound in the remote northern Chiang Mai district of Chai Prakan. The site is dominated by a 4 level wooden building.

-**Orange Orchard**, you can pick off some fresh oranges or buy some souvenirs like fresh oranges, aroma candles or bags from the store. Dinner at local restaurant (Suki Yunnan)

D3: Chiang Rai

(B/L/D)

-**Doi Mae Salong**, is a hill of Dan Lao range in Chiang Rai province, Thailand 6 km. from the border with Burma. This mountain rises in Mae Fa Luang District. Its summit is near the town of Santikhiri which is built on the ridge.

-**Chiang Mai Sakura**, You can experience the **sakura cherry blossom** in **Chiang Mai**. Lunch at local restaurant.

-**Chui Fong Tea Plantation**, huge, scenic tea plantation offering tours & a gift shop, plus a modern cafe with a terrace with drink and cake included. It has an atmosphere of **tea plantations** that are planted around the hillside where tourists can stop to take photos and see the beauty in many places. Dinner at local restaurant.

-**Chiang Rai Walking Street**, is a must-visit for some excellent shopping and bites to eat; offering unique items that you can only find in this region.

-**Chiang Rai Clock Tower**, It is the most beautiful **clock tower** in Thailand and has a light and sound performance for 10 minutes three times per day at 19.00, 20.00, and 21.00 hrs

D4: Chiang Rai

(B/L/D)

-**Mae Sai - Thai Burma Border**, the northernmost district (*amphoe*) of Chiang Rai province in northern Thailand. The town of Mae Sai is a major border crossing between Thailand and Myanmar. Asian Highway Network AH2 (Thailand Route 1 or Phahonyoth Road) crosses the Mae Sai River to the town Tachileik in Myanmar.

-**Golden Triangle**, where the borders of three countries; Thailand, Laos, and Myanmar, see the panoramic view of Mekong Rive with Boat Trip Along Mae Khong River. Lunch at restaurant.

-**Opium House**, Located in the ancient city of Chiang Saen in **Chiang Rai**, the **Opium House** Museum is a small museum dedicated to displaying the history of **opium** products.

-**Sigha Park** - Tram Included, Scenic park in a farm like setting with tea plantations, orchards, trails, a tram & a petting zoo. Dinner at restaurant.

D5: Chiang Rai – Chiang Mai

(B/L/D)

-Huay Pla Kang Temple + Fortune Pagoda, Temple complex featuring a 9-floor pagoda with 12 surrounding structures & a giant Buddha.

-White Temple, Wat Rong Khun, better known as “the White Temple” is one of the most recognizable temples in Thailand. The temple outside the town of Chiang Rai attracts a large number of visitors, both Thai and foreign, making it one of Chiang Rai’s most visited attractions. Lunch at local restaurant. Back to Chiang Mai.

-Mae Kajan Hot Spring, One of the few natural hot springs in northern Thailand, the Mae Kachan Hot Spring (Mae Kajan is so hot—reaching temperatures of 194°F (90°C—it can boil an egg in minutes, a feat that locals are more than happy to demonstrate. As well as cooking your breakfast, you can dip your toes in several pools.

D6: Chiang Mai

-Inthanon National Park - Highest Point of Thailand, is one of the most popular **national parks** in Thailand. It is famous for its waterfalls, few trails, remote villages, viewpoints, sunrise/sunset

- King and Queen Pagoda, these magnificent **pagodas** were dedicated to the royal grace of **King** Rama 9 and the **Queen** of Thailand. The brown one is the **king's** & the purple one is the **queen's**.

-Tribe Market, full of beautiful clothes, textiles and souvenirs, handmade by the local village **tribes**. Lunch at restaurant.

-Wachirathan Waterfall, is in the area of Doi Inthanon National Park. **Chiang Mai** Province **Wachirathan Waterfall** originated from Mae Klang creek.

-Doi Kham Temple, Most of the temples in Chiang Mai are influenced by Lanna architecture and characterized by curved wooden roofs facing the sky. There are a few temples not to be missed when visiting Chiang Mai, one of which is the Wat Phra That Doi Kham temple.

-Otaru Chiang Mai, Mae Kha Canal in **Chiang Mai** is popular with its resemblance to **Otaru** Canal in Japan and has many Japanese-inspired shops you can explore. After dinner walk at Night Market.

-**Warorod Market**, locally known as Kad Luang is a market and one of tourist attractions in Chiang Mai Province, regarded as the largest and most well-known market in the north region of Thailand.



After Lunch, transfer to Chiang Mai Airport for your flight back to Singapore.
